Dear Families,

The character values, which the children are learning about this month, are Respect and Tolerance. We have talked to the children about what these values might look like in day to day practical terms, and how they can be respectful and tolerant, both at school and at home.

The children are very respectful in school, particularly towards adults and each other. Unfortunately, over the last couple of weeks, we have had some incidents of equipment in school being deliberately broken, and children taking home school resources (without permission) in their bags and pockets.

The staff work incredibly hard to provide inspiring learning opportunities, with teachers spending a great deal of time and effort (and their own money sometimes!) preparing and sourcing equipment. I have spoken to the children today about taking care of our things in the same way that we take care of each other, and how lucky we all are to learn in such a wonderful, new school with fantastic resources. Hopefully there will be no more incidents like this, but if there are then I will be contacting parents directly to pay for any equipment that their child has deliberately broken or damaged.
