County Hall building works - information provided by UK Power Networks

UK Power Networks Services Ltd will be carrying out works within the County Hall staff car park (rear of building) in the not too distant future. This work will entail the fencing off of areas of the car park meaning that access will be restricted and certain areas un accessible during the works.

As with previous phases of the works (resurfacing the entrance road) we will maintain a walkway around the works to the school for pedestrians. We must stress however, that attempting to cross the site for a short cut is extremely unsafe and dangerous. As far as is reasonably practical, we will not have any gaps in our fence line but sometimes these do appear but it would be foolhardy to use these openings as shortcuts across the site.

Our target date for commencement of works would be 24th October. This will include:

Resurfacing Works for Phase 2 (ph1 was the completion of the access road completed in summer holidays) Resurfacing Works and Civil excavations for Ph 3 3D render of new solar car ports Elevations and sections of new Solar Car ports Civil Excavations routes and works... Note these are directly adjacent to the footpath through the car park which will be diverted around the County Hall.

In addition to these works, there will also be works occurring on the grassed area to the North West of the pond which will entail a large excavation again requiring the footpath to be diverted. We are trying to programme this so that it takes place after the major works in the car park.
